Dawn Rose

The rose has long been recognized as a symbol of love. Captured in bronze, these elegant roses will be a remembrance of unending love for generations to come.

An endearment scroll is included at no additional charge. You may select any one of the following phrases:

Dogwood

Through the ages, dogwood blossoms have represented Christ's divine love for mankind. This bronze memorial, graced by the flower of the atonement, expresses faith in the redemption of the soul.

FLORAL BOUQUET

Six different exquisite flowers, in full bloom, signify an appreciation of life's splendor. Preserved in bronze, these examples of nature's beauty are a fitting tribute to cherished memories.

This type of memorial, with a single large scroll, is used for single interment. The Floral Bouquet can also be adapted for double interment. Any of the borders (Pine Edge, Dawn Rose, and Dogwood) may be used for single or double interment applications.

PINE EDGE

The pine bough, forever green, is an age-old symbol of regeneration. Cast in bronze, this majestic evergreen serves as a reminder of life everlasting and a lasting tribute.
